

## Affordability of Early Care and Education

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### *Impact of Child Care Costs on Families*

#### **Private Market Rates** (*private rate provider charges without scholarship or negotiation*).

A comparison of Private Market Rates reported in 2007 to those reported in 2008 shows the following:

- Average **full-time** infant care in a **Family Child Care Home** increased by **\$4.74** per week from **\$148.19 to \$152.93**.
- Average **full-time** infant care in **Child Care Facilities** increased by **\$11.34** per week from **\$197.17 to \$208.51**.
- Average cost of **part-time** elementary age **before and after school** care increased by **\$1.41** per week from **\$52.86 to \$54.27**.

#### **What does this mean to families?**

A family of four in Pinellas County that includes an infant and a 3 year old and who are living at **200%** of the Federal Poverty Level (\$42,400 gross income) can expect:

- **41 %** of their gross annual income will be spent on child care in a **Child Care Facilities** (based on average private market rate).
- **36%** of their gross annual income will be spent on child care in a **Family Child Care Home** (based on average private market rate).

A family of four in Pinellas County that includes an infant and a 3 year old and who are living at **150%** of the Federal Poverty Level (\$31,800 total gross income) can expect:

- **54%** of their gross annual income will be spent on child care in a **Child Care Facilities** (based on average private market rate).
- **48%** of their gross annual income will be spent on child care in a **Family Child Care Home** (based on average private market rate).

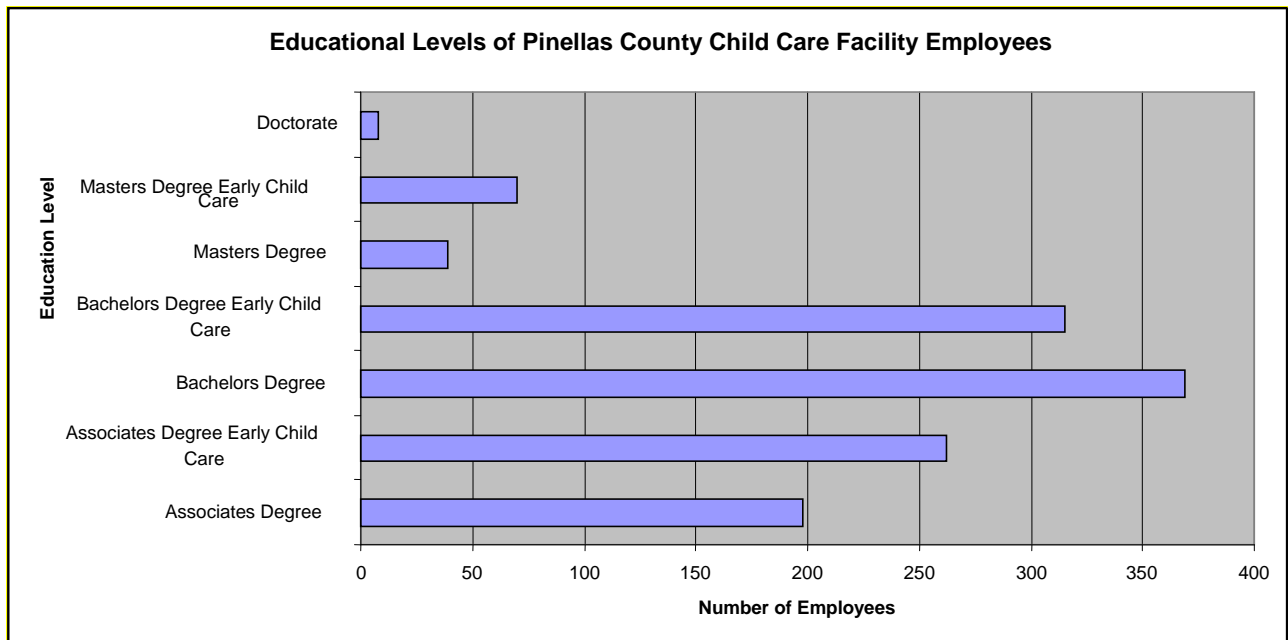

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### Child Care Executive Partnership Program

Created by the Florida Legislature in 1996, the Child Care Executive Partnership (CCEP) program is an innovative, public/private partnership program that helps employers meet the needs of their workforce — working parents. Through this program, private sector business dollars and parent fees are matched with federal and state funding, dollar for dollar, to provide child care services to participating families.

The CCEP's mission is to assist working families with child care costs, much like other benefits. The CCEP program helps working families keep working while helping ensure child care needs are met. Eligible families must be at or below 200 percent of the Federal poverty level. Parents participate by paying a portion of the costs based on a sliding fee scale. Quality child care provides opportunities for children to enter school ready to learn and provides a foundation for success in the classroom and in life. Achievement in the classroom is vital to creating a better prepared workforce now and in the future.
