Dear Parent/Guardian:

Thank you for calling Child Care Resource and Referral of Pinellas (CCR&R) for assistance with your child care needs. Choosing a child care provider is one of the most important decisions you will make as a parent. It is crucial that you choose a child care provider who meets the needs of your child and with whom you feel comfortable.

The enclosed list of child care providers is based on the information you gave us related to your child's age, type of care requested, location preferred, and any other needs that you specified. Each family's situation and each child are unique; therefore, only you can best determine which child care provider is right for you. We share your concern for finding quality child care and therefore hope that the enclosed information is helpful to you in making your selection. Please note that these providers are not rated or recommended by Child Care Resource and Referral, Coordinated Child Care or Pinellas County Health Department (PCHD) Child Care Licensing Program.

We encourage you to follow these important steps beginning with contacting the child care providers on your list to arrange interviews and visits with at least three providers before making your selection. We are enclosing a child care checklist that will help you know what to look for and what questions to ask. Be sure to discuss the specific needs of your child and the providers' philosophies and policies to make sure they are compatible with your own ideas and values. After you have carefully interviewed your potential providers we urge you to check references before placing your child in care.

When you have narrowed your choice to either two or three providers through interviews, visits and reference checks, we recommend you contact a licensing specialist who will review with you the licensing history of those specific caregivers.
