Enrichment Overlay System

The Out of School Time Enrichment Overlay System provides additional resources for out of school time programs to engage 9-14 year old youth, sustain participation, and promote school success. Coordinated Child Care of Pinellas, Inc. will contract with overlay providers and coordinate services for OST and 21st CCLC providers.

CCC expects all OST/21st CCLC sites to continue to use their own established agency enrichment services and agency funding streams, as well as, participate in the overlay service offered by CCC.

Menu Selection Procedure

- **Youth input and participation in the menu selection process is highly encouraged by CCC as best practices for quality OST programs.**
- CCC will organize and coordinate all scheduling of CCC approved overlay services.
- Providers may choose from the provided menu of overlays.
- Upon request of overlays, CCC requires all OST sites submit their before/ after school and summer schedule to aid in site matching.
- Overlay funds will be distributed as evenly as possible among sites. This may impact the amount of overlays the agency/site can receive per fiscal year.
- Note that a request for an overlay does not guarantee overlay implementation. Site matching and coordination is contingent on the OST site and the Overlay Provider's schedule of availability.
- Prior to Overlay implementation, the OST/21stCCLC sites must confirm schedule with the Overlay Provider.
- Prior to Overlay implementation, OST/21stCCLC must sign and submit to CCC the Overlay Memo of Understanding.
